Meeting called to order at 6:06pm by **Debbie Launer**

### GUESTS:

--**Steve Jensen, Melinda James & Shari/Van Horn Elementary School.**

They were there to talk to us about their upcoming car show which takes place on Sat., March 28 and brought flyers to distribute. They are trying to make it better every year. They do surveys of everyone attending as well as the parents and student to try to improve the show. They will have a different t-shirt this year. If you register before March 7<sup>th</sup> you will get a t-shirt. Also added a barbeque trailer. The kids are really getting excited about the show. They will have bounce houses too. Kids show too. Book Fair going on. Theme this year will be "Lights, Camera, Action". They will also have the usual craft vendors.

- **Danny Rodriguez** announced the club winning the 2009 "Best Represented Club" was **OFCC**. They had (14) paid entries!!
- Official check presentation to **Patricia Henson/Society for Disabled Children of Kern County** will take place at the April BCCC meeting.

- **Danny Rodriguez** announced that **Pablo Perrazo** has had to close his business, **American Dreams**, and now has a 1979 Camaro RS with t-tops that he intends to donate to the Super Raffle for the 2010 Super Cruise event! He has taken it to “**Skinny**” to do the restoration. **Debbie** already has \$20 towards this raffle. The car needs the motor put back in. **Gil Edmondson** will donate it. The car should actually be ready in six months. **Gil** moved to wait three months to begin selling raffle tickets for this and **Fred Evenson** seconded the motion. We will bring this up again at the April BCCC meeting. The motion passed.
- It was announced that **John Fleming/OFCC** lost two brand new grey chairs at the event. If anyone find them or discovers they picked them up by mistake, please let **John** know (661/619-8635) or notify **Debbie**. **Debbie** is also missing two clipboards after the event. If you happen to have picked them up, please get them back to her.
- **Debbie** thanked **OFCC** for all their work. Things went very smoothly. The only negative comment was that people started the Poker Run before 8am. Prior to the event, **Gil** was at the Fairgrounds before 5am to talk to the television stations. **Gil** and **Debbie** made a plug on the Inga Barks Show on the radio. Nice prizes. **Studebaker Club** was very organized with the Raffle. **Outlawz, Chevy Ltd., Vintage Ltd.** – thanks to all of these clubs and to **Danny Rodriguez** for the help. We had a lot of positive feedback. A lot of people came late because of the early fog, but the weather, all in all, turned out great. Took in \$1,700 on the Raffle, and the 50/50 drawing winner’s half was \$400+. There were 120 cars pre-registered and a total of 165 cars by the end of the day. There were 10 or 12 cars pre-registered that didn’t pick up their registration. Had 6 dozen donuts and 60 cups of coffee and only made \$15 in donations. There were people taking donuts and coffee that weren’t part of the show and didn’t contribute. It was suggested that next year we put a price on the coffee and donuts so the car club that contributes these won’t lose money.
- Everyone that attended commented on how they thought the show went. Another downside was that we only sold \$400 worth of event t-shirts. This was lower than expected.
- **Lynn Hubbard** said she thought the music was excellent but that the speakers could have been turned in such a way that everyone could hear it better. **Gil** said the Poker Run started out foggy but no big deal! Next year maybe get the t-shirts done early so people can wear them to help advertise. We still owe **John Fleming** \$500 for plaques. **Debbie** still has a little over \$1,000 to deposit and we got back \$568 from **Wall Street Imprintables**.

- **Debbie** would like to see the show being from 9am to 3pm next year. There were lots of Super Raffle prizes. **Leroy Kelly**, the DJ, donated his time and equipment. A big THANK YOU goes out to him! Twenty-eight clubs participated.
- **Danny** thanked all the car clubs that helped with the Poker Run. Everyone agreed that we should not wait until next January to start planning next year’s show.

--**ACCC** Update. **Fred Evenson** said the Legislature cannot introduce any new bills right now because of everything that is going on in the State with the budget not being settled. The State is officially bankrupt. Air Resources Board is not planning anything. However, SB32 is referring to global warming.
